GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. The abstract must be an original work, which may include research studies or case reports in the fields of Infection, Tropical Diseases, or Miscellaneous Topics.
2. Submit the abstract to the committee via email at panitia@asmpid2025.com no later than July 18, 2025. Abstracts submitted after this date will not be accepted.
3. Accepted abstracts will be presented in E-Poster format during the Offline Session.
4. The abstract presenter must be a registered participant and attend the ASMPID 2025 Offline Symposium

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

1. The abstract must be written in English using Arial font, size 11 pt, single spacing.
2. The maximum word count is 250 words, excluding the title and author names.
3. The abstract title must be written in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS.
4. Author names should be written in full, with first name followed by last name, using both uppercase and lowercase letters.
5. The first-listed author is considered the primary author. The presenter's name must be underlined.
6. Author affiliations must be written in full and in the following order: department, institution/hospital, city.
7. Avoid using:
 - Non-standard abbreviations
 - Foreign terms
 - Uncommon symbols or acronymsIf used, they must be defined at their first mention.
8. Use generic drug names. Numbers should be written in numeric form
9. The abstract must be in text-only format. Tables, charts, and diagrams are not allowed.
10. References should not be included. If they are, they will count toward the total word count

ABSTRACT & POSTER

RESEARCH ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

1. BACKGROUND / OBJECTIVE: Rationale and objective of the study.
2. METHOD: Study design and statistical analysis used.
3. RESULTS: State whether the hypothesis is accepted or rejected, supported by statistical data if relevant.
4. CONCLUSION: The implications of the results for patient management or understanding of basic disease processes.

CASE REPORT ABSTRACT STRUCTURE

1. BACKGROUND / OBJECTIVE: Rationale for reporting the case, novelty, and clinical relevance.
2. CASE: A concise description of the case
3. CONCLUSION: Clinical implication, practical recommendation, awareness, or suggestion for further research

POSTER GUIDELINES

1. E-Posters must be written in English.
2. Submit in PDF format, one page only, with a vertical (portrait) orientation.
3. E-Poster design should be created using Microsoft PowerPoint.
 - Slide size: 19.05 cm x 33.87 cm (7.5 in x 13 in), portrait orientation.
4. The top section of the E-Poster must include:
 - E-Poster title
 - Author names without academic titles (presenting author listed first, followed by co-authors)
 - Complete affiliations
 - The presenter's name must be underlined
5. The main content of the E-Poster should include:
 - Objective / Background
 - Methodology / Case Description
 - Results
 - Conclusion
6. Images, photos, graphs, and tables are allowed.
7. The E-Poster must be self-explanatory.
 - For discussions or questions, a direct WhatsApp contact for the presenter may be provided.
8. Once completed, save the E-Poster as a PDF file.
9. Submit the final E-Poster PDF to the committee via email at panitia@asmpid2025.com no later than July 26, 2025.
